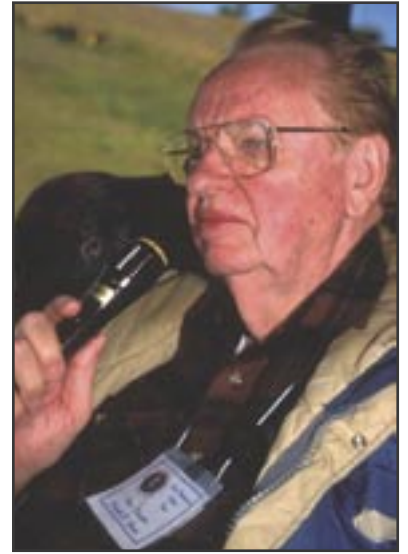

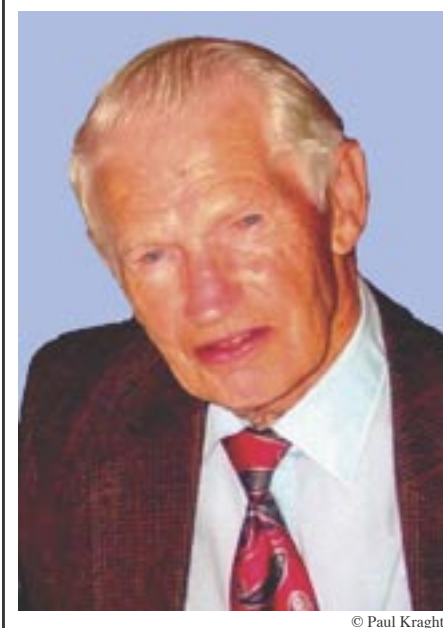

Board Bio: Bert Kraght

Bert Kraght, FPSA, DFS4C, was born on a dairy farm in the town of Lynden, Washington, half a mile from the

Canadian border. His parents were Dutch and spelled their name "Kragt," but his oldest brother added the "h" to make a phonetic "f." Each morning before school and evening before dinner, Bert had five cows to milk. But farming wasn't in his blood; he went to college, became a food technologist, and worked some years for the Washington Co-op, producers of

Lynden chicken products. Then he was lured southward by a firm dealing with fruit and vegetable packing and shipping. The lure was tuition to U. C. Berkeley to get a PhD in microbiology, after which he became Director of Research in the company's decay control lab in Monrovia, where he stayed until retirement. He met Margaret about a year after moving to southern California, and less than a year later they were married.

As Margaret liked to paint, they took water colors with them on their honeymoon and several vacations thereafter. But when Crater Lake's myriad shades of blue stumped them, they decided to try photography and rented a camera for their next vacation, taking slides. Pleased with the results, they bought a camera and started taking pictures of family and vacations. One night at a church program they saw a show by Neil Shipley, which impressed them greatly. Neil invited them to visit Glendora Color Slide Group (of which he was President), and that did it.

Bert has been President of Glendora twice and also of Wind & Sun Council. In 1986 the Kraghts were co-Chairmen of the first Golden West International, which they had also originated, and Bert has been General Chairman from 1992 to 2002. Meanwhile, he and Margaret were Chairmen of the S4C Salon (including its special 25th), Chairmen of El Camino Salon, and have also been Chairmen of the

PSA Salon several years and Chairmen of the PT Section of the PSA Salon this year and three other years. Thanks to the encouragement and sponsorship of Bryan and Gladys Riggs, they earned APSAs in 1989 and became FPSAs seven years later. Meanwhile, Bert had served many terms on both S4C and Wind & Sun Councils, earning his DFS4C. And of course he judges, both for clubs and Internationals.

Photographically, his interests are many: He has earned a Galaxy in Color Slides, 5 Stars in Nature, 4 in Photo Travel, and 3 in Photojournalism. Now he has added Video to his interests and is quite active in the Los Angeles Cinema Club. When his job took him abroad to Spain, Italy, and Israel; the Kraghts abandoned camping and backpacking for foreign travel and have visited every continent but Antarctica. They've also done extensive traveling in the western United States. Next trip? Perhaps a seventh or eighth visit to Switzerland with son, Paul, who would love those Alps.

Bert's other interests include volunteering at Recording for the Blind & Dyslexic (textbooks, usually math), gardening, classical music (the Kraghts are regular attendees at both Pasadena and the L.A. Philharmonic), bridge, and crossword puzzles. Additionally, he cooks all the breakfasts at the Kraght house, with a large and wonderful variety of recipes he's collected and adapted. Food Technology lives on!
